**4. Station Tours**

**5. SPOT 127**

SPOT 127, KJZZ's Youth Media Center is an innovative program for youth ages 14-24 that is designed to engage students in education through digital media and journalism. Students are inspired and empowered to find news stories in their community, research topics, develop stories, record interviews, and then produce original digital media pieces. In 2018-2019 the program provided extra-curricular learning opportunities to nearly 250 high school students in Maricopa County at both its Spot127-East and Spot127-West locations.

A. Paid Internship Program - During the 2018-19 school year, SPOT 127 hired ten high school students. Their primary role was to help with instruction to younger students as well as to actively report on stories through the use of video, audio, and online publishing. The students were selected through a formal application and interview process which provided them with the real world experience of interviewing for employment.

B. Foundation Partners - SPOT 127 continued to receive broad support from the community for general operations and to expand the program into the East Valley.
